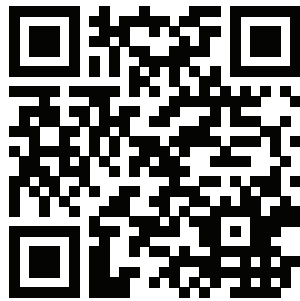

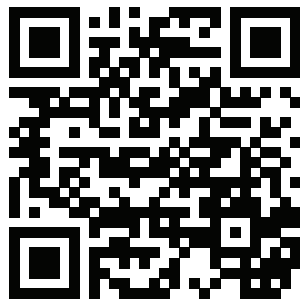

Safety Rules and Regulations

- Georgia law requires child safety seats for children 7 years of age and younger.
- Georgia law prohibits the use of cell phones by drivers under the age of 18.
- Writing, sending or reading text messages or emails while driving is against the law in Georgia.
- Drivers are required, by state law, to yield to pedestrians in crosswalks.
- Pedestrians should use crosswalks when available.

POV Information

- Non-resident military personnel may elect to register their POV in Georgia for a nominal tag fee.

- Non-resident military personnel also may elect to obtain a Georgia driver's license. The requestor must present a birth certificate or passport, proof of address, social security card and a copy of military orders. There is no requirement for a written or driving test.

Pets

- Pets in family housing must be microchipped at the vet clinic and registered with Balfour Beatty Communities.
There is a limit of two pets per household, and residents must pay a non-refundable pet fee of \$150.00 per pet.
- For inoculations and routine pet care, contact the post veterinary clinic at 706-787-3815.

- Students living on the installation attend Richmond County schools.

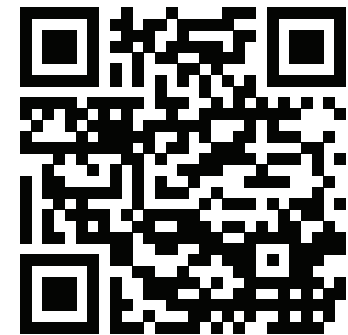

Privately Owned Weapons

- All privately owned firearms, pellet guns, BB guns, bows, and crossbows stored on the installation must be registered with the military police within three working days of arrival or of obtaining the firearm or weapon.
- Privately owned firearms may be brought onto Fort Gordon only for hunting, dog training, using shooting ranges, and participating in shooting or marksmanship events. Firearms must be registered with the military police using FG Form 9243. Complete information on registration, transportation, and use of firearms is available in FG Regulation 210-13, which is available along with the registration form at www.gordon.army.mil.
