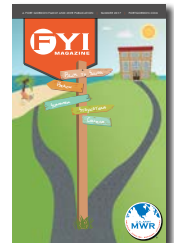

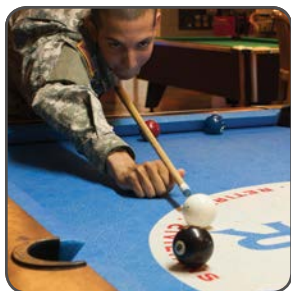

## SPECIAL EVENTS

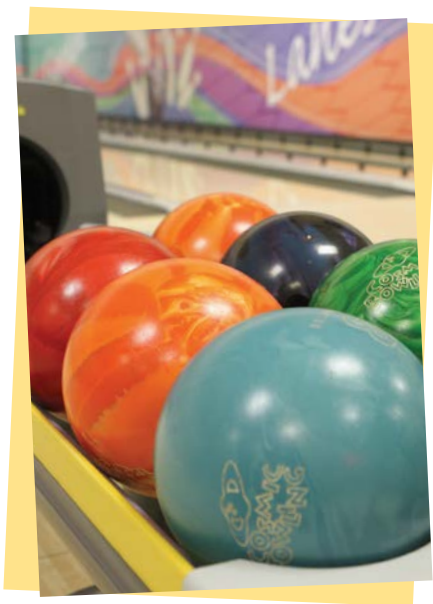
