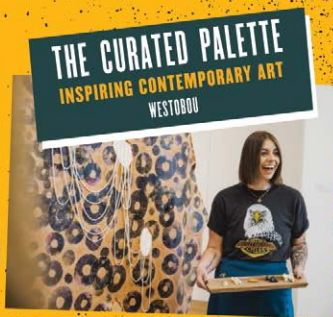
FAMILY & MWR MISSION STATEMENT

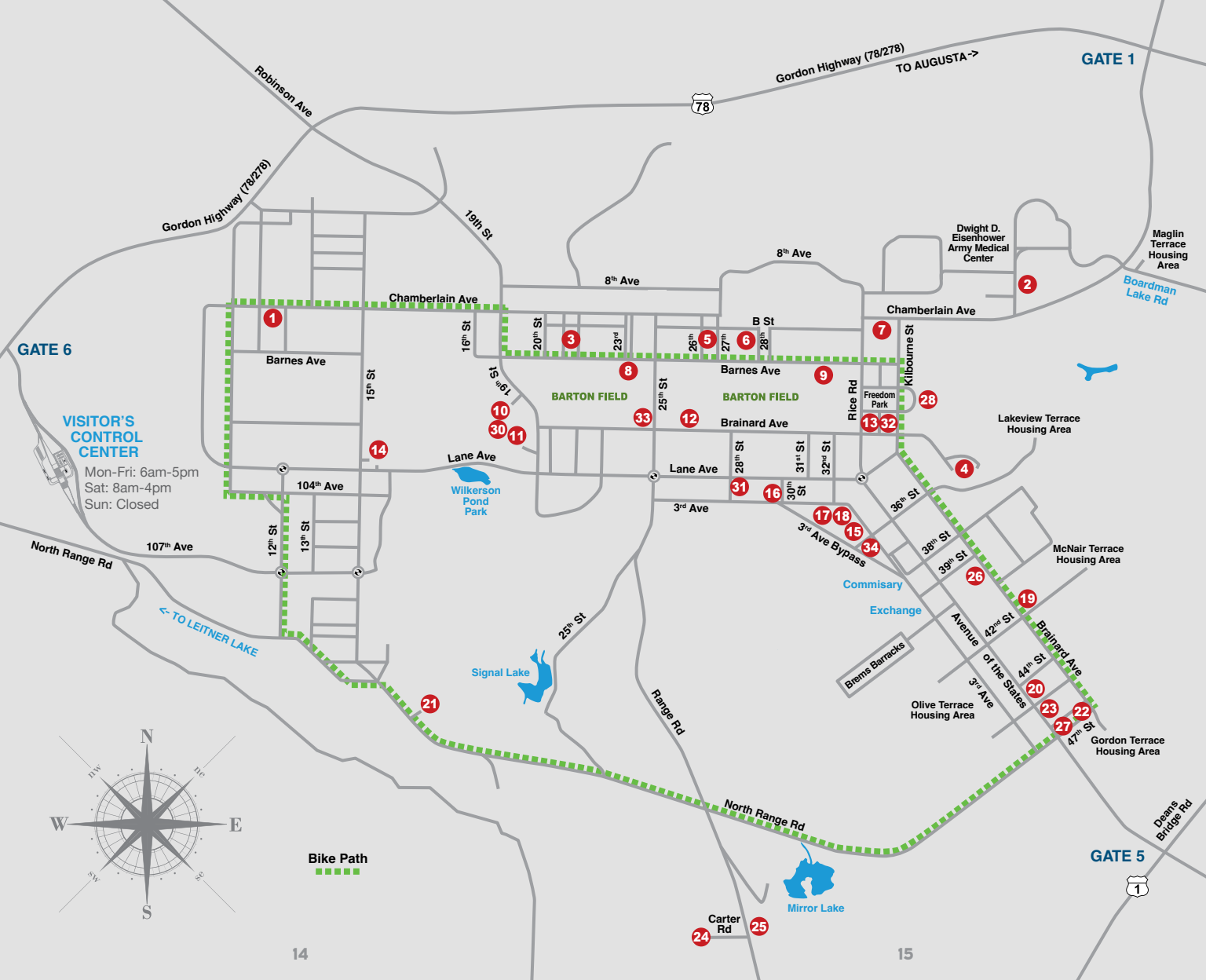

These programs reduce the conflict between parental responsibilities and unit mission requirements, support readiness and contribute to the quality of family life.

Before/After School

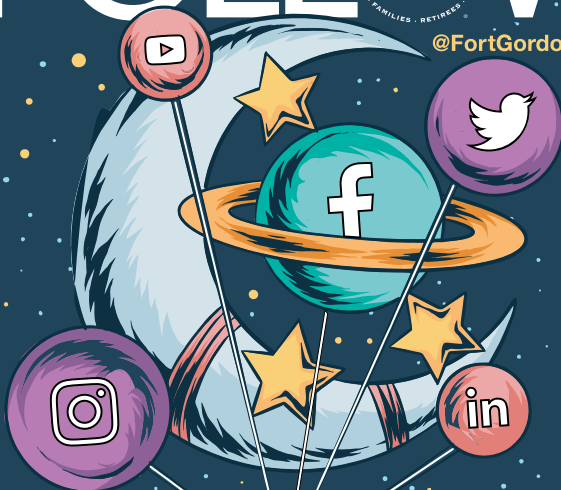
