

These programs reduce the conflict between parental responsibilities and unit mission requirements, support readiness and contribute to the quality of family life.

### Before/After School

Before and after school programming is available for kindergarteners and 1st-5th graders before and/or after the school day. Transportation to and from selected public schools off-post is based on the availability of transportation. Children who attend Freedom Park will walk to and from school/care by a CYS staff member(s).
